


The Coldest Girl in Coldtown, **Holly Black**





The Scorpion Rules, Erin Bow




The Testing, Joelle Charbonneau

Rot & Ruin, Jonathan Maberry




Not a Drop to Drink, Mindy McGinnis


Orleans, Sherri L. Smith
