



Saint Anything by Sarah Dessen


Frostfire by Amanda Hocking


All The Bright Places by Jennifer Niven



The Truth About Us by Janet Gurtler




The Rest of Us Just Live Here By Patrick Ness


Things We Know By Heart By Jessi Kirby

A story of first love, family, loss, and betrayal told from different points in time, and in separate voices, by artists Jude and her twin brother Noah.




What We Left Behind by Robin Talley

Toni and Gretchen have been together forever. When they separate for their first year at college they're sure they'll be fine. The reality of being apart, though, is very different than they expected.




Everything, Everything By Nicola Yoon
