


Magical Girl Apocalypse by Kentaro Sato


Twin Star Exorcists by Yoshiaki Sukeno


The Devil is a Part-timer by Satoshi Wagahara


Deadman Wonderland by Jinsei Kataoka


The Ancient Magus' Bride by Kore Yamazaki
