General OneFile Find an article on almost any topic in Hispanic and Latinx American history and culture. Start at www.brightonlibrary.org, chose "Databases," then "News & Research," then "General OneFile." Try typing keywords "Hispanic" or "Latin" to start; the database will offer related terms that may be useful in your search.
