General OneFile Find an article on almost any topic in Asian American history. Go to brightonlibrary.org, choose "Databases," then "News & Research," then "General OneFile." Try typing keywords "Asian American" to start; the database will offer related terms that might be useful in your search.

NoveList Plus is a great resource for finding Asian American fiction and nonfiction titles. Go to brightonlibrary.org and choose "Databases."

Pronunciator is an online language learning program that teaches practical conversation in 100+ languages. Learn any of these languages through self-directed lessons, live teachers, movies, music, and more. Go to brightonlibrary.org, choose "Databases," then "Buying/Legal/Language," then "Pronunciator," then "Instant Access," and finally "Launch Pronunciator."

The best way to find music through Hoopla is to isolate the format (a drop down next to the search box) to music. Then, search by artist or album title or genre, or even search terms like "Asian American."
